Emergency Medical Technician Course

This course is offered to individuals who are at least **18** years of age and are interested in developing a greater understanding of Emergency Medical Services for either personal or professional gain. This course meets requirements for local and National certification as an EMT-Basic.

Areas of topic include:

- **Basic anatomy and physiology**
- **Patient assessment**
- **Airway management**
- **Medical and traumatic emergencies**
- **Obstetric emergencies**
- **Special considerations for pediatric and geriatric populations**
- **Individuals with special needs**
- **EMS operations**

Successful course completion enables a student to apply to take the National Registry for EMT's exam, required for certification. In addition, students must obtain a Department of Justice background check through Live Scan in order to seek employment within the Fresno, Madera, Tulare, and Kings counties. Individuals with questions regarding previous criminal records are encouraged to contact California Emergency Medical Services Authority at **916-322-4336**. Those seeking employment within the ambulance industry are required to possess a valid medical examiners card, ambulance driver's license, and second Live Scan as mandated by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
